- From engine parts to body paint, fluids to wipers, maintenance to repairs, Volkswagen has everything you need to keep your Volkswagen properly tuned and looking its best.
- Any minor accident repair should not void the limited new vehicle warranty and/or the collision warranty if done properly. Only your Volkswagen Dealer can ensure proper repair to factory standards using Volkswagen original parts.

What to do?

In case of a collision:

- Even if it's just a bump, stop in a well-lit place away from traffic.
- Call the police and request an ambulance if needed.
- Gather your driver's license, registration and insurance to present to the police.
- Fill out the collision report on page 2 of this brochure.
- If handy, use your cell phone or a digital camera to take photos of the damage.

Contact Volkswagen Roadside Assistance for towing service to your preferred Volkswagen dealer within 50 km or the nearest authorized Volkswagen dealership. Beyond the warranty coverage, you may request the same Roadside service for a fee.
